**PROPOSED TAX LEVY (REPLACEMENT)
WYANDOT COUNTY
A Majority Affirmative Vote Is Necessary For Passage.**

A replacement of a tax for the benefit of Wyandot County for the purpose of **PROVIDING THE WYANDOT COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH WITH SUFFICIENT FUNDS TO CARRY OUT ITS HEALTH PROGRAMS** at a rate not exceeding 0.7 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to seven cents (\$0.07) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five years, commencing in 2009, first due in calendar year 2010.

PROPOSED BOND ISSUE AND TAX LEVIES

**CAREY EXEMPTED VILLAGE SCHOOL DISTRICT
SENECA AND WYANDOT COUNTIES
A Majority Affirmative Vote Is Necessary For Passage.**

Shall the Board of Education of the Carey Exempted Village School District be authorized to do the following:

(1) Impose an annual income tax of one-quarter percent (0.25%) on the school district income of individuals and of estates, for twenty-eight (28) years beginning January 1, 2010 for the purpose of **GENERAL PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS, INCLUDING PAYING THE COST OF LOCALLY FUNDED INITIATIVES FOR THE SCHOOL DISTRICT S'CLASSROOM FACILITIES PROJECT (INCLUDING AN AUDITORIUM), AND THE FINANCING OF SECURITIES THEREFOR?**

and

(2) Issue bonds for the purpose of **PAYING THE LOCAL SHARE OF SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION UNDER THE STATE OF OHIO CLASSROOM FACILITIES ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, INCLUDING CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW PK THROUGH 12 FACILITY AND DEMOLITION OF EXISTING FACILITY, TOGETHER WITH ALL NECESSARY APPURTENANCES THERETO**, in the principal amount of Twelve Million One Hundred Fifteen Thousand One Hundred Forty-Seven Dollars (\$12,115,147) to be repaid annually over a maximum period of twenty-eight (28) years, and levy a property tax outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the county auditor to average over the bond repayment period nine (9) mills, for each one dollar of valuation which amounts to ninety cents (\$0.90) for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, commencing in 2009, first due in calendar 2010, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?

and

(3) Levy an additional tax for a period of twenty-three (23) years to benefit the Carey Exempted Village School District, the proceeds of which shall be used **TO PAY THE COST OF MAINTAINING THE CLASSROOM FACILITIES INCLUDED IN THE PROJECT** at the rate of one-half (0.50) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to five cents (\$0.05) for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, commencing in 2009, first due in calendar year 2010?

**PROPOSED TAX LEVY (RENEWAL)
VANLUE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT
A Majority Affirmative Vote Is Necessary For Passage.**

Shall a levy renewing two existing levies be imposed by the Vanlue Local School District for the purpose of **PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY REQUIREMENTS OF THE VANLUE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT** in the sum of \$325,000 and a levy of taxes to be made outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the county auditor to average 10.6 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to one dollar and six cents (\$1.06) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of ten (10) years, commencing in 2009, first due in calendar year 2010? If approved, any remaining tax years on either of the above two existing levies will not be collected after tax year 2008 (collection year 2009).

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the Wynford Local School District for the purpose of **CURRENT OPERATING EXPENSES** at a rate not exceeding 6.9 mills for each dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.69 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 3 years, commencing in 2009, first due in calendar year 2010.

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

Shall a levy renewing an existing levy be imposed by the Wynford Local School District for the purpose of **AVOIDING AN OPERATING DEFICIT** in the sum of \$350,000 and a levy of taxes to be made outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the county auditor to average 2.79 mills for each dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.279 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of 3 years, commencing in 2009, first due in calendar year 2010?
