4. FCFC Reporting –

a. Early Intervention - Kristi Swartz

Currently 18 active cases in Early Intervention. Received 5 new referrals, 1 from the hospital, 1 from Children Services, and 3 from parents.

b. Prevention Report – Justin Swartz

Finished the Keeping It Real programming at JFS, one session for middle school age students and another session for high school age students. Had 10 kids in the program and only 3 middle school students completed it. Juvenile probation wants to try running it again.

Still waiting for OhYes Data to be released, hoping to have it by the next coalition meeting to evaluate the direction of the coalition focus in the future.

Working with the HUB on Wednesdays to help them run their current programming.

Current awareness campaigns we are running are, Gambling prevention.

The Prevention Coalition meets via Zoom on the 2nd Tuesday of every month at 9:00am.

c. FCFC Service Coordination – Greg Parker

OASCIS data is getting caught up in the system for year-end processing.

The service coordination committee meets the 2nd Thursday of every month at 8:30am.

I will be taking wraparound training in August.

The new Governor project for the new department of Youth and Children increased some of the FCFC budgets including EI increasing from \$37,000 to \$57,000 and OCBF doubled from \$15,750 to \$31,500.

a. Mental Health and Recovery Services Board – Robin Reaves

The board is planning for the Fiscal Year 2024 funding.

A second women's recovery home is being opened in Seneca County July 2, 2023.

- b. **Job & Family Services – Jason Fagan**
Nothing new to report currently.
 - c. **Children’s Services – Megan Rowe**
Now have Narcan onsite and training is being done on how to distribute.
A new employee just started and is in the process of being trained.
 - d. **Health Department –**
Anna Gibson – now has 3 new Battelle trained evaluators at the health department giving a total of 4.
Have Narcan available to the community to have for personal use and will come with training on how to use it.
Krystina Auble - COVID waivers end in August which will lower milk and vegetable amounts for moms and children.
Will have the farmers market where families will get \$30 in fresh fruits and vegetables from a local farm.
August 19th at the EMS Building WIC and HMG HV will have a Community Baby Shower from 10-11:30am.
Yajaira Ayala - HMG Home Visiting currently has 25 families and has 3 credentialed home visitors again. Have room for 3 more families in the program.
 - e. **Preschool Head Start – Aimee Nye**
Remodeling of the building and parking lot repaving will be happening soon.
Classes in Upper will be changed this fall from 2 half day classes to 1 full day class.
 - f. **Service Coordination Committee -**
Nothing new to report. Meets monthly via Zoom on the 2nd Thursday at 8:30am.
