- 1. Call to order of the September 13, 2023, FCFC Executive Committee meeting by Scott Moore, Vice-Chair**
- 2. In Attendance:** Greg Parker, Brad Batton, Linda Stansbery, Todd Dilley, Scott Moore, Kelli Owens, Elyssa Hays and Vanessa Krizek.
- 3. FCFC Director's Report – Greg Parker**
 - EI Supervision with Lori Stidham is going well and now we are working simultaneously with Kim Pachis at NCOESC to allow her to cross-train before the end of Lori's contract.
 - The corrective action plan with the State for EI is going forward and is going well.
 - Began looking into cellphones for the office staff to separate office and personal functions due to Sunshine Laws and public records and looking for feedback from other departments.
 - The Heath Department stated they are moving away from contracts and using stipends instead. The few devices they have are through Verizon.
 - The City of Upper Sandusky uses Verizon for some employees.
 - More discussions will come after more research, budget review and when pricing comes back from the Verizon rep and T-Mobile rep.
- 4. Strong Families Safe Communities Grant Approval with Lucas County FCFC**
 - We need approval for a 2-year continuance of services for Strong Families Safe Communities Grant for \$50,000. The county collaboration has increased to 8 counties and there is potential for an increase in funding that we would find out about when the contract comes out.

- 5. Subgrant G-2425-060328 Contract Approval with the Ohio Department of Jobs and Family Services for Fiscal Years 2024 & 2025**
 - Contract for \$54,990 each year for a breakdown of each part as: Operational Capacity Building Funds (OCBF) \$30,750, Multi-System Youth (MSY) Admin \$3,600 and Family Centered Services and Supports (FCSS) \$20,640.
 - OCBF amount is double what we've received in previous years and FCSS increased a small amount.

- 6. Other Announcements or Business**
 - County Fair is going on this week. We are handing out Detera bags, 1st aid kits, sign-ups for medication lockboxes.
