

KOEHLER SURVEYING, INC.
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**LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF A 12.8 ACRE PARCEL
FOR BOWMAN FARMS**

Being a parcel of land situated in part of the Southeast part of Cherokee Boy Section in the East Half of Section 21, T-1-S, R-14-E, Tymochtee Township, Wyandot County, Ohio, and further described as follows:

Commencing at a 1" diameter iron pipe on the north line of a parcel of land now or formerly owned by J. Craig Bowman marking the southeast corner of Lot #6 of the Cherokee Boy Section and being the **POINT OF BEGINNING**;

thence N 89° 15' W along the north line of said Bowman parcel and the south line of said Lot #6 a distance of 914.0 feet to a point on the east bank of the Sandusky River;

thence N 03° 45' E along the east bank of the Sandusky River a distance of 447.2 feet to a point;

thence N 19° 24' E along the east bank of the Sandusky River a distance of 208 feet to a 1" diameter iron rod on the south line of a parcel of land formerly owned by Otto Foust;

thence S 86° 40' E along the south line of former Foust parcel a distance of 836.0 feet to a 1" diameter iron pipe on the east line of the Cherokee Boy Section marking the southeast corner of the former Foust parcel and the southwest corner of a parcel of land formerly owned by Charity A. Parker;

thence South along the east line of the Cherokee Boy Section a distance of 614.84 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**.

Containing in all 12.8 acres of land, more or less, being subject to all legal highways and easements of record.
