LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in the southwest quarter of Section 12, Marseilles Township, Town-4-South, Range-12-East, Wyandot County, Ohio described as follows:

Commencing at a found stone in a monument box marking the south quarter post of said section and the centerline of Township Highway 94; thence N 00o 00' 00" E one hundred sixteen and sixteen hundredths (116.16) feet along the centerline of said highway and north-south quarter section line to a set railroad spike, THE POINT OF BEGINNING;

thence N 89o 45' 46" W four hundred sixty-two and forty-two hundredths (462.42) feet to a set iron rod, passing at eighteen and no hundredths (18.00) feet a set iron rod on line for reference;

thence N 00o 00' 00" E three hundred ninety-six and eleven hundredths (396.11) feet to a set iron rod;

thence N 72o 03' 15" E four hundred eighty-six and seven hundredths (486.07) feet to a set railroad spike on the centerline of Township Highway 94 and the north-south quarter section line, passing at four hundred sixty-six and ninety-two hundredths (466.92) feet a set iron rod on line for reference;

thence S 00o 00' 00" W five hundred forty-seven and seventy-nine hundredths (547.79) feet along the centerline of Township Highway 94 and the north-south quarter section line to THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all, 5.010 acres of land, more or less, subject to all legal highways and easements.

Bearings are assumed and for angular measurement only.
