LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in the northeast quarter of Section 12, Eden Township, Town-2-South, Range-14-East, Wyandot County, Ohio described as follows:

Commencing at a found stone marking the south quarter post of said section and the centerline of County Highway 44 and also marking the southwesterly corner of a parcel of land now or formerly owned by Doris Gwinner as described in Deed Volume 113, page 449 in the Wyandot County recorder's office; thence N 01° 09' 34" E two thousand six hundred forty and fifty-three hundredths (2640.53) feet along the north-south quarter section line and said Gwinner's westerly line to a found two (2) foot diameter concrete post marking the center of said section, **THE POINT OF BEGINNING**;

thence N 00° 59' 39" E five hundred fifty and forty-two hundredths (550.42) feet along the north-south quarter section line to a set railroad spike in the root of a twenty (20) inch diameter maple tree;

thence S 76° 57' 15" E one thousand one hundred forty-seven and thirty-three hundredths (1147.33) feet to a set iron rod;

thence S 01° 08' 11" E two hundred eighty-nine and seventy-nine hundredths (289.79) feet to the east-west quarter section line and the northeasterly corner of a parcel of land now or formerly owned by Doris Gwinner as described in Deed Volume 113, page 449 in the Wyandot County Recorder's office;

thence S 89° 55' 04" W one thousand one hundred twenty-one and fifty-three hundredths (1121.53) feet along the east-west quarter section line to **THE POINT OF BEGINNING**.

Containing in all, 10.819 acres of land, more or less, subject to all legal highways and easements.

Bearings are assumed and for angular measurement only.
