

SURVEY DESCRIPTION

Situated in the Township of Antrim, County of Wyandot, State of Ohio and being a part of the Northwest Quarter Section Thirty-three (33), Township Three (3) South, Range Fifteen (15) East, and being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin set at the intersecting centerlines of State Route 294 and Township Highway 135, the place of beginning.

Thence South $75^{\circ}52'50''$ West, along and with the centerline of St. Rt. 294, a distance of 246.77 feet to a railroad spike set;

Thence North $01^{\circ}00'00''$ West, parallel with the centerline of Twp. Hwy. 135, and passing over an iron pin set at 30.88 feet, a distance of 224.04 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence North $89^{\circ}00'00''$ East and passing over an iron pin set at 215.33 feet, a distance of 240.33 feet to a railroad spike set in the centerline of Twp. Hwy. 135;

Thence South $01^{\circ}00'00''$ East, along and with the centerline of Twp. Hwy. 135, a distance of 168.03 feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 1.082 acres of land more or less and subject to legal highways, easements, and restrictions of record.

The foregoing description was prepared from an actual field survey completed on April 7th, 1991 and performed by Jacques M. Glaze, Registered Surveyor #6817.

Bearing reference was taken from Survey Volume 3, Page 67, dated Nov. 21st, 1882 on file in the Wyandot County Tax Map Office and as shown on the accompanying plat of survey dated April 8th, 1991 prepared by J. Glaze.

All points designated "iron pin set" have a 5/8" diameter, epoxy coated rebar in place with a yellow plastic cap bearing the inscription "Jacques Glaze Surveyor 6817".
