## LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in the northeast quarter of Section 15, Pitt Township, Town-3-South, Range-14-East, Wyandot County, Ohio described as follows:

Commencing at a found stone in a monument box marking the centerline intersection of County Highway 60 and Township Highway 59 and on the north line of said section 15; thence N 89° 58' 59" E four hundred ten and ninety-six hundredths (410.96) feet along the centerline of Township Highway 59 and the north line of said Section 15 to the northeasterly corner of a 2.657 acre parcel of land now or formerly owned by Jeffrey and Barbara McClain as described in Deed Volume 186, page 393 in the Wyandot County Recorder's office, **THE POINT OF BEGINNING**;

thence N 89° 58' 59" E sixty-five and zero hundredths (65.00) feet along said centerline and said section line to a set railroad spike;

thence S 00° 02' 00" E two hundred eighty-eight and eleven hundredths (288.11) feet to a set iron rod, passing at twenty and zero hundredths (20.00) feet a set iron rod on the southerly right-of-way of said highway;

thence S 89° 58' 20" W sixty-five and zero hundredths (65.00) feet to a found iron rod marking the southeasterly corner of said McClain's 2.657 acre parcel;

thence N 00° 02' 00" W two hundred eighty-eight and twelve hundredths (288.12) feet along said McClain's easterly line to **THE POINT OF BEGINNING**.

Containing in all, 0.430 acres of land, more or less, subject to all legal highways and easements.

Bearings are assumed and for angular measurement only.
