**LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF A 1.597 ACRE
PARCEL FOR JOHN LAUDICK**

Being a parcel of land situated in part of the northwest quarter of section 14, T-3-S, R-14-E, Pitt Township, Wyandot County, Ohio, and further described as follows:

Commencing at a found railroad spike marking the intersection of the centerlines of CH 124 and TH 59;

thence S 00° 11' 25" W along the centerline of CH 124, a distance of 2165.76 feet to a set P-K nail and being the POINT OF BEGINNING;

thence continuing S 00° 11' 25" W along said centerline, a distance of 100.00 feet to a set P-K nail;

thence N 89° 17' 46" W, a distance of 308.35 feet to a set iron rod, passing a set iron rod a distance of 17.50 feet;

thence S 54° 11' 30" W, a distance of 254.32 feet to a set iron rod;

thence N 86° 33' 38" W, a distance of 109.96 feet to a set iron rod;

thence N 20° 29' 27" E, a distance of 248.54 feet to a set iron rod;

thence S 89° 08' 50" E, a distance of 228.78 feet to a set iron rod;

thence S 00° 11' 25" W, a distance of 26.40 feet to a set iron rod;

thence S 89° 08' 50" E, a distance of 233.28 feet to a set iron rod;

thence N 62° 50' 06" E, a distance of 85.15 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING, passing a set iron rod a distance of 65.47 feet.

Containing in all 1.597 acres of land, more or less, subject to

all legal highways and easements of record.

Bearings are assumed for angular measurement only.
