

Description for Charles Karcher

Situated in the Southeast Quarter of Section 13, Township 3 South, Range 14 East, in the Township of Pitt, County of Wyandot, State of Ohio, and described as follows:

Commencing at a stone in a monument box found at the Southeast Corner of said Section 13 which is also the intersection of centerlines of County Highway 62 and County Highway 128;

thence North $0^{\circ}16'05''$ East along the east line of said Section 13, which is also the centerline of County Highway 128, a distance of 2,079.10 feet to a railroad spike set at the place of beginning.

From the place of beginning, thence continuing North $0^{\circ}16'05''$ East along the east line of said Section 13, which is also the centerline of County Highway 128, a distance of 310.00 feet to a railroad spike set;

thence North $89^{\circ}43'55''$ West a distance of 340.00 feet to a 5/8" dia. iron pin with cap marked "PS 7007" set, passing over a 5/8" dia. iron pin with cap marked "PS 7007" set at 20.00 feet;

thence South $0^{\circ}16'05''$ West a distance of 310.00 feet to a 5/8" dia. iron pin with cap marked "PS 7007" set;

thence South $89^{\circ}43'55''$ East a distance of 340.00 feet to the place of beginning, passing over a 5/8" dia. iron pin with cap marked "PS 7007" set at 320.00 feet,

containing a calculated area of 2.420 Acres of land, and subject to all legal easements of record.
