SURVEY DESCRIPTION

15.836 ACRES

Situated in the Township of Marseilles, County of Wyandot, State of Ohio, being a part of the Southeast Quarter Section Seven (7) of Township Four (4) South, Range Thirteen (13) East and being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Beginning for the same at a railroad spike set in the Centerline of State Route 37 at said Centerline's intersection with the North Line of the Southeast Quarter Section 7, thence South  $33^{\circ}-49'-55''$  East, along and with the aforesaid Centerline of St. Rt. 37 a distance of 1629.37 feet to a magnetic nail found;

Thence South  $76^{\circ}-42'-08''$  West, along and with an existing property line and passing over an iron pin found at 32.14 feet, a distance of 904.15 feet to an iron pin found in the West Line of the East Half of the Southeast Quarter Section 7;

Thence North  $91^{\circ}-00'-00''$  West, along and with the aforesaid West Line of the East Half of the Southeast Quarter Section 7 and passing over an iron pin set at 1506.35 feet, a distance of 1561.68 feet to the Place of Beginning.

Containing 15.836 acres of land more or less and subject to legal highways, easements, and restrictions of record.

The point designated "iron pin set" has a 5/8 inch diameter, epoxy coated rebar in place with a yellow plastic cap bearing the inscription "Jacques Glaze Surveyor 6817".

Bearing Reference was assumed North as shown on the accompanying Plat of Survey dated October 22nd, 2000 and prepared by J.M. Glaze.

The foregoing description was prepared from an actual field survey performed on September 30th, 2000 by Jacques M. Glaze, Registered Surveyor No. 6817, and field assistant Marden T. Watts.
