LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in the southeast quarter of Section 18, Pitt Township, Town-3-South, Range-14-East, Wyandot County, Ohio described as follows:

BEGINNING at a found stone in a monument box marking the north eighth post of the southeast quarter of said section and the centerline of County Highway 115; thence S 00° 00' 00" W five hundred and zero hundredths (500.00) feet along north-south eighth line of the southeast quarter of said section and the centerline of County Highway 115 to a set P-K nail;

thence S 89° 05' 12" W five hundred and zero hundredths (500.00) feet to a set iron rod, passing at thirty and zero hundredths (30.00) feet a set iron rod on the westerly right-of-way of said highway;

thence N 00° 00' 00" E five hundred and zero hundredths (500.00) feet to a set iron rod on the east-west quarter section line of said section;

thence N 89° 05' 12" E five hundred and zero hundredths (500.00) feet along said east-west quarter section line to the north-south eighth line of the southeast quarter of said section and the centerline of County Highway 115 THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all, 5.739 acres of land, more or less, subject to all legal highways and easements.

Bearings are assumed and for angular measurement only.
