thence continuing N 89° 32' 10" E along the centerline of Township Highway 18 a distance of 175.00 feet to a set MAG nail;

thence S 00° 15' 11" E a distance of 525.00 feet to a set iron rod, passing a set iron rod a distance of 30.00 feet;

thence S 89° 32' 10" W a distance of 175.00 feet to a set iron rod;

thence N 00° 15' 11" W a distance of 525.00 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, passing a set iron rod a distance of 495.00 feet.

total distance of 447.17 feet to a set MAG nail and being the **POINT OF BEGINNING**,  
referenced by a set iron rod situated S 00° 15' 11" E a distance of 30.00 feet;

thence continuing N 89° 32' 10" E along the centerline of Township Highway 18  
extended, a distance of 175.00 feet to a set iron rod on the south line of a parcel of land  
currently owned by John H. Reinbolt, et ux, passing a found iron rod a distance of 40.00  
feet;

thence S 00° 15' 11" E a distance of 525.00 feet to a set iron rod;

Being a parcel, which has its origin<sup>in</sup>/a parcel conveyed in reference Deed Book 204 at page 551 which is situated in the state of Ohio, County of Wyandot, Township of Tymochtee and part of the Northeast, Southeast, Southwest and Northwest Quarters of Section 32, Township 1 South, Range 14 East and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a railroad spike found (referenced by a personalized half inch iron pipe set with cap bearing South 52 degrees 48 minutes 36 seconds West and being 52.44 feet distant.) at the intersection of the centerline of County Road Number 38 with the centerline of State Road Number 53;

thence on an assumed bearing of South 04 degrees 24 minutes 13 seconds West along the centerline of State Road Number 53 (this bearing is based on the centerline bearing of State Road Number 53 and all other bearings are from angles and distances measured in the field ) for a distance of 1,188.49 feet to a half inch head metal nail set, the place of beginning;

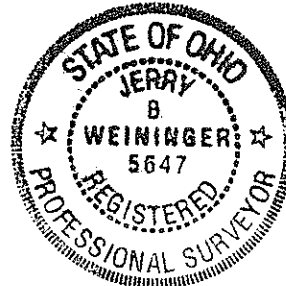

thence South 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West on said line for a distance of 30.09 feet to a personalized half inch iron pipe set with cap as a reference;

thence South 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West on said line for a distance of 879.31 feet to a personalized half inch iron pipe set with cap;

thence North 00 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East on a line for a distance of 405.43 feet to a personalized half inch iron pipe set with cap;

thence North 89 degrees 47 minutes 16 seconds East on a line for a distance of 910.79 feet to a personalized half inch iron pipe set with cap as a reference;

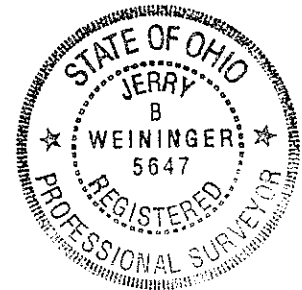

the place of beginning and containing 8.647 acres, more or less, but subject to all legal highways and easements of record, with 0.283 acres being within the right-of-way of State Road Number 53, with 0.660 acres in said Northeast quarter, with 1.596 acres in said Southeast quarter, with 4.626 acres in said Southwest quarter and with 1.765 acres in said Northwest quarter.
