

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LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in the northeast quarter of Section 8, Tymochtee Township, Township-1-South, Range-14-East, Wyandot County, Ohio, described as follows:

Commencing at a found stone in a monument box marking the north quarter post of said Section 8 and the centerline of Township Highway 11;

Thence S $89^{\circ} 41' 11''$ E one thousand eight hundred thirty-nine and ninety-five hundredths (1839.95) feet along the north line of Section 8 and said centerline to a found railroad spike marking the centerline of State Route 53 from which a set iron rod for reference bears S $45^{\circ} 00' 00''$ W twenty (20) feet;

Thence S $29^{\circ} 50' 03''$ W one thousand three hundred thirty-five and sixty-four hundredths (1335.64) feet along said centerline to a set nail from which a set iron rod for reference bears N $90^{\circ} 00' 00''$ W twenty (20) feet;

Thence S $14^{\circ} 21' 28''$ W eight hundred twelve and zero hundredths (812.00) feet along said centerline to a found railroad spike from which a set iron rod for reference bears N $90^{\circ} 00' 00''$ W twenty (20) feet;

Thence S $16^{\circ} 05' 28''$ W four hundred seventy-three and sixty-nine hundredths (473.69) feet along said centerline to a set nail marking the northwesterly corner of a 1.0 acre parcel of land now or formerly owned by Randy Payne as described in Wyandot County Deed Volume 185, page 655, from which a set iron rod for reference bears S $73^{\circ} 41' 58''$ E thirty and zero hundredths (30.00) feet;

Thence S $73^{\circ} 41' 58''$ E one hundred ninety-eight and forty-two hundredths (198.42) feet along said Payne's northerly line to a found iron pipe marking the northeasterly corner thereof, **THE POINT OF BEGINNING**;

Thence S $73^{\circ} 41' 58''$ E four hundred nineteen and thirty-five hundredths (419.35) feet to the meandering low water line of the Sandusky River, passing a set iron rods on line for reference at two hundred fifty-two and zero hundredths (252.00) feet and at three hundred eighty-four and thirty-five hundredths (384.35) feet;

Thence S $16^{\circ} 06' 22''$ E sixty-five and seventy-seven hundredths (65.77) feet along said low water line of the Sandusky River to the east-west quarter section line, from which a set iron rod for reference bears S $89^{\circ} 41' 42''$ W forty-eight (48) feet;

Thence S $89^{\circ} 41' 42''$ W four hundred seventy-four and thirty-nine hundredths (**474.39**) feet along said section line to a found iron pipe marking the southeasterly corner of a 1.0 acre parcel of land now or formerly owned by Randy Payne as described in Wyandot County Deed Volume 185, page 655;

Thence N $16^{\circ} 18' 00''$ E one hundred ninety-one and ten hundredths (**191.10**) feet along said Payne's easterly line to **THE POINT OF BEGINNING**.

Containing in all, **1.266** acres of land, more or less, subject to all legal highways and easements.

The bearing of the east-west quarter section line is assumed South $89^{\circ} 41' 42''$ West.

Bearings are assumed and for angular measurement only.

All iron rods set are $5/8''$ diameter by $30''$ length with personalized caps marked HANK AND ASSOC. driven flush.
