TRACT 1 LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in part of Lot 3 and the southwest quarter and southeast quarter of Section 3, Eden Township, Township-2-South, Range-15-East, Wyandot County, Ohio, described as follows:

Commencing at a found railroad spike marking the west quarter post of said Section 3 and the northwest corner of said Lot 3 and the centerline of State Route 231 from which a set iron rod for reference bears N 85° 50' 01" E 30.00 feet;

thence N 85° 50' 01" E nine hundred forty-four and sixteen hundredths (944.16) feet along the east-west quarter section line and the north line of said Lot 3 to a set iron rod marking the northeasterly corner of an 8 acre parcel of land now or formerly owned by Merle R. and Anna M. Goodman as described in Wyandot County Deed Volume 161, Page 51, **THE POINT OF BEGINNING**;

thence N 85° 50' 01" E six hundred thirty-two and fifty-seven hundredths (632.57) feet along said east-west quarter section line and north line of said Lot 3 to a found wood post marking the northeast corner of said Lot 3 and the east line of the former Indian Reservation, said post referenced by a set iron rod on the northerly side of said post;

thence S 89° 40' 23" E one thousand fifty-eight and fifteen hundredths (1,058.15) feet along said east-west quarter section line to a set iron rod marking the center of said Section 3;

thence N 89° 39' 08" E six hundred forty-six and sixty-one hundredths (646.61) feet along said east-west quarter section line to a found iron rod marking a northwesterly corner of a 61.369 acre parcel of land now or formerly owned by Richard W. Shellhouse, etux as described in Wyandot County Deed Volume 204, Page 322;

thence N 06° 21' 07" E two hundred fifty-three and eighty-eight hundredths (253.88) feet along the easterly line of said Goodman's 10 acre parcel to a set iron rod marking the northeasterly corner thereof;

thence S 89° 58' 13" W thirty-seven and twenty-six hundredths (37.26) feet along the northerly line of said Goodman's 10 acre parcel to a set iron rod marking the southeasterly corner of a parcel of land formerly owned by J. A. Horick as described in Wyandot County Deed Volume 66, page 360;

Goodman as described in Wyandot County Deed Volume 161, Page 51;

thence S 86° 03' 58" W six hundred forty-three and seventy-eight hundredths (643.78) feet along the northerly line of said Goodman's 44 acre parcel to a set iron rod marking the southeasterly corner of said Goodman's 8 acre parcel;

thence N 01° 39' 16" E three hundred seventy-four and seventy-seven hundredths (374.77) feet along the easterly line of said Goodman's 8 acre parcel to **THE POINT OF BEGINNING**.

Commencing at a found railroad spike marking the west quarter post of said Section 3 and the northwest corner of said Lot 3 and the centerline of State Route 231 from which a set iron rod for reference bears N 85° 50' 01" E 30.00 feet;

thence N 85° 50' 01" E nine hundred forty-four and sixteen hundredths (944.16) feet along the east-west quarter section line and the north line of said Lot 3 to a set iron rod marking a northwesterly corner of a 24 acre parcel parcel of land now or formerly owned by David Wood, et ux, as described in Wyandot County Deed Volume 199, Page 948;

thence S 01° 39' 16" W three hundred seventy-four and seventy-seven hundredths (374.77) feet along the westerly line of Wood's 24 acre parcel to a set iron rod marking a southwesterly corner thereof;

thence N 86° 03' 58" E six hundred forty-three and seventy-eight hundredths (643.78) feet along the southerly line of said Wood's 24 acre parcel to a set iron rod marking the east line of the former Wyandot Indian Reservation and the southwesterly corner of a parcel of land formerly owned by J. thence $N 85^\circ 50' 01'' E$ nine hundred forty-four and sixteen hundredths (944.16) feet along the east-west quarter section line and the north line of said Lot 3 to a set iron rod marking a northwesterly corner of a 24 acre parcel parcel of land now or formerly owned by David Wood, et ux, as described in Wyandot County Deed Volume 199, Page 948;
