thence continuing S 90° 00' 00" W along said centerline a distance of 260.00 feet to a found railroad spike marking the southeast corner of a parcel of land currently owned by Daniel Courtad;

thence N 00° 29' 31" W along the east line of said Daniel Courtad parcel a distance of 418.86 feet to a set iron rod, passing a set iron rod for reference a distance of 25.00 feet;

thence N 90° 00' 00" E a distance of 260.00 feet to a set iron rod;

thence S 00° 29' 31" E a distance of 418.86 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, passing a set iron rod for reference a distance of 393.86 feet.

Containing in all 2.500 acres of land, more or less, of which 0.149 acre, more or less, is currently contained within highway right-of-ways. The above described property being subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

All set iron rods are 5/8" diameter with personalized plastic caps.
