

**KOEHLER SURVEYING

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**LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF A 0.154 ACRE PARCEL
FOR VFW POST 3759**

Being a parcel of land situated in part of Lots 126 and 127 of the Original Plat of the Village of Carey, Wyandot County, Ohio, and further described as follows:

Commencing at a point marking the southwest corner of Lot 127 of the Original Plat of the Village of Carey, referenced by a found iron rod marking the intersection of the centerlines of Vance Street and South Street situated S 53° 46' 18" W a distance of 46.65 feet;

thence on an assumed bearing of N 08° 45' 00" E along the west line of said Lot 127 a distance of 60.00 feet to a point marking the northwest corner of a parcel of land currently owned by Judith Yeater and being the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, said point being referenced by a set drill hole in concrete situated N 81° 12' 24" W a distance of 1.00 foot;

thence continuing N 08° 45' 00" E along the west line of said Lot 127 a distance of 69.00 feet to a found drill hole in concrete marking a southwest corner of a parcel of land currently owned by D. A. Underwood, et al;

thence S 81° 12' 24" E along a southerly line of said Underwood parcel a distance of 66.00 feet to a point marking a southeast corner of said parcel, passing a found iron rod for reference a distance of 41.86 feet;

thence N 08° 45' 00" E along an east line of said Underwood parcel a distance of 20.01 feet to a drill hole in concrete marking a corner of said parcel;

thence S 81° 12' 21" E along a south line of said Underwood parcel a distance of 24.00 feet to a point referenced by a set iron rod situated N 08° 45' 00" E a distance of 6.00 feet;

thence S 08° 45' 00" W a distance of 89.01 feet to a set iron rod on the north line of said Yeater parcel;

thence N 81° 12' 24" W along said line a distance of 90.00 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**.

Containing in all 0.154 acre of land, more or less, being subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

Bearings are assumed and are for angular measurement only.

All set iron rods are 5/8" diameter with personalized plastic caps.
