

KOEHLER SURVEYING, INC.
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**LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF A 0.115 ACRE PARCEL
FOR JAMES AND BARB CLARK**

Being a parcel of land situated in part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 6, T-1-S, R-13-E, Crawford Township, Wyandot County, Ohio, and further described as follows:

Commencing at a found stone in a monument box marking the intersection of the centerlines of County Highway 3 and County Highway 96;

thence on an assumed bearing of S 01° 08' 33" W along the centerline of County Highway 96 a distance of 834.88 feet to a found railroad spike marking the northeast corner of a parcel of land currently owned by the Clark Revocable Living Trust;

thence N 89° 01' 29" W along the north line of said Clark Revocable Living Trust parcel a distance of 175.00 feet to a set iron rod marking the northwest corner of said parcel and being the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, passing a found iron pipe for reference a distance of 19.93 feet;

thence S 01° 07' 58" W along the west line of said Clark Revocable Living Trust parcel a distance of 200.00 feet to a found iron rod marking the southwest corner of said parcel;

thence N 89° 01' 30" W a distance of 25.00 feet to a set iron rod;

thence N 01° 07' 58" E a distance of 200.00 feet to a set iron rod;

thence S 89° 01' 29" E a distance of 25.00 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**.

Containing in all 0.115 acres of land, more or less, being subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

Bearings are assumed and are for angular measurement only.
