thence on said northwesterly extension, S27°30'00"E, a distance of 101.18 feet to an iron pin found marking the northeasterly corner of said 4.000 acre tract;

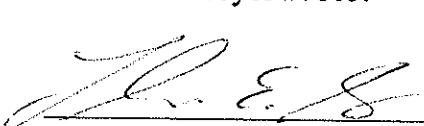
