LEGAL DESCRIPTION

The Hutton Company

1.237 Acres

Situated in the Village of Carey, County of Wyandot, State of Ohio, and being part of the E1/2 of the NW1/4 of Section 20, T1S, R13E, a tract of land bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a stone and monument box found at the southwest corner of the NW1/4 of Section 20;

thence along the south line of said NW1/4, S89°55'54"E, a distance of 946.87 feet to the intersection of said south line with the southerly right-of-way line of State Route No. 103 (Variable R/W) and being 95.00 feet right angle dimension south of Station 280+45 in the centerline survey of said State Route No. 103, referenced by an iron pin found lying 0.06 feet north and 0.15 feet east of said point;

thence along the southerly right-of-way line of said State Route No. 103, N72°56'12"E, a distance of 1033.57 feet to an iron pin found marking a point of curvature;

thence continuing along said southerly right-of-way line and on a curve segment to the left having a radius of 2934.79 feet, a central angle of 06°32'34" and a length of curve of 335.13 feet, the chord of said curve segment bearing N67°33'56"E, a distance of 334.94 feet to an iron pin set and being the PRINCIPAL Point of Beginning of the tract of land herein described;

thence from the above described PRINCIPAL Point of Beginning and continuing along said southerly right-of-way line and on a curve segment to the left having a radius of 2934.79 feet, a central angle of 03°50'53" and a length of curve of 197.10 feet, the chord of said curve segment bearing N62°22'13"E, a distance of 197.06 feet to an iron pin found marking the northeast corner of a 2.147 acre tract of land as described in O.R. Volume 153, Page 742 and O.R. Volume 153, Page 744 of the Wyandot County Deed Records;

thence along the easterly line of said 2.147 acre tract, S19°19'44"E, a distance of 291.63 feet to an iron pin found marking the southeast corner of said 2.147 acre tract;

thence along the south line of said 2.147 acre tract, S70°40'16"W, a distance of 195.00 feet to an iron pin set;

thence parallel with the easterly line of said 2.147 acre tract, N19°19'44"W, a distance of 263.17 feet to the PRINCIPAL Point of Beginning and containing 1.237 acres of land, more or less, subject however to all prior easements of record.
