said river and it being a part of the South part of the North West
Quarter and the North East part of the South West Quarter of Section
Number 1 Township Number 1 North of Range Tenth East First
Meridian (T. 1. S.) And running then North 33 chains and
42 links to Sugar 5 in S 69 3/4 E 29 links Back 15 in S 54 E
11 links thence East 30 chains 16 links to (Sandusky River)
