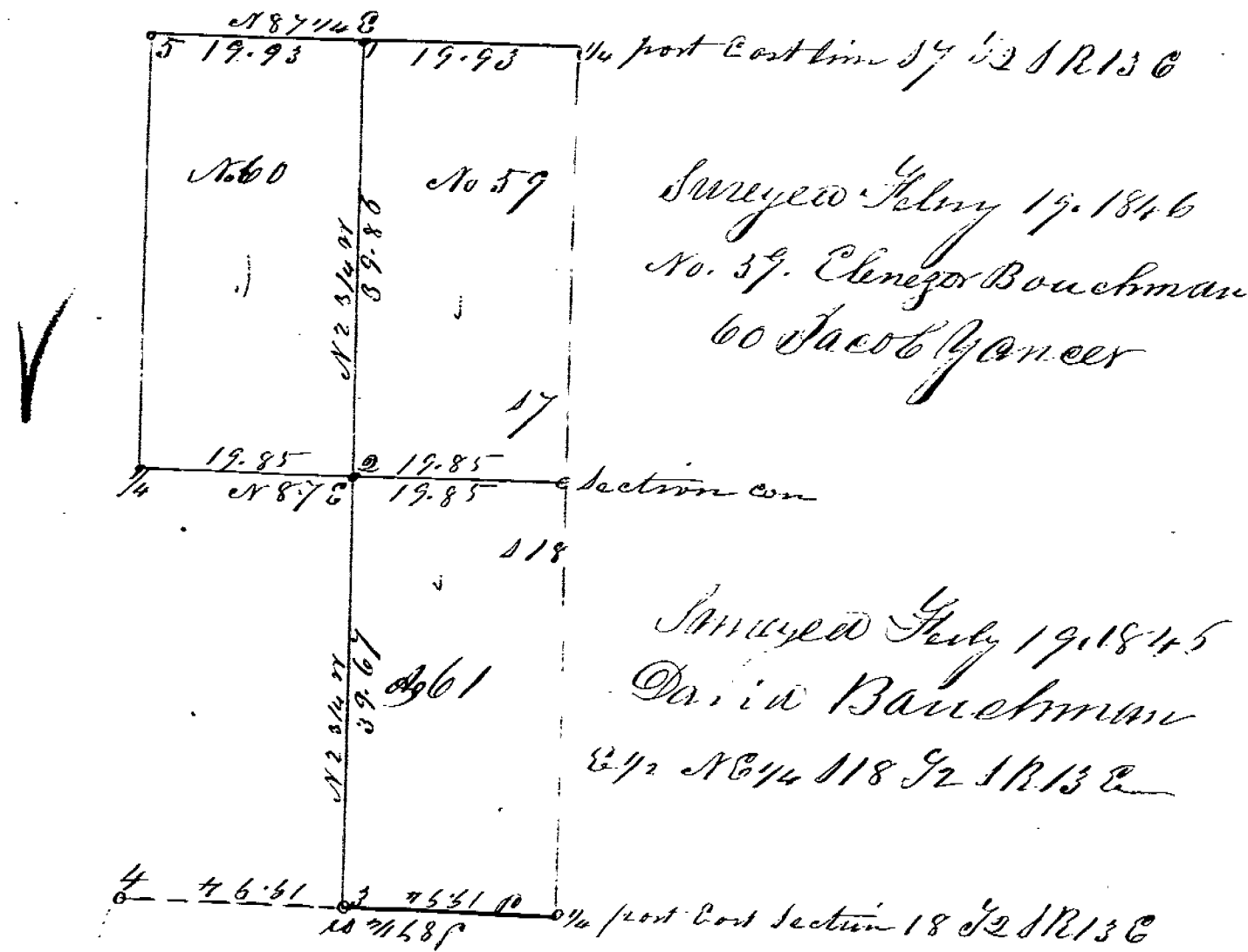
Survey of Studick Best November 3, 1845

It being the $N\frac{1}{2}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section No 9 T. 1 R. 13 E.

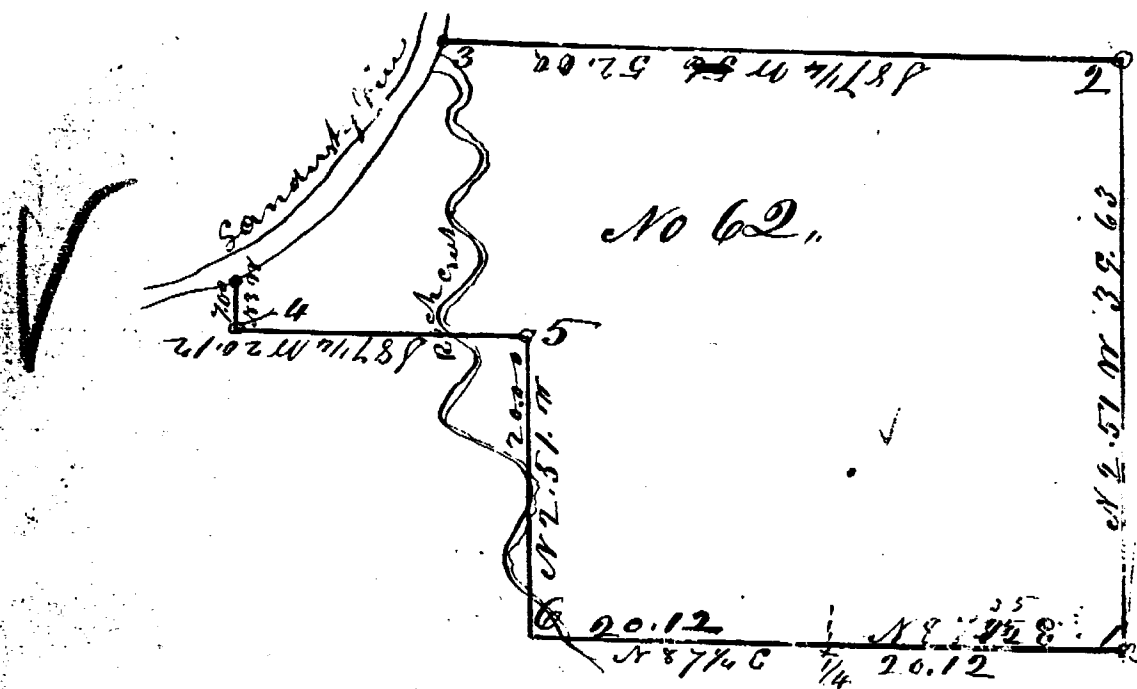
Beginning at the NW corner of said section running thence

6 in $S 86\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W 125$ thence $N 87^{\circ} E 40.24$ to W oak 16 in $S 85^{\circ} E 39\frac{1}{2}$
 W oak 12 in $N 29^{\circ} E 76$ thence $N 34\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W 20.00$ chains (to $1/4$ post)
thence W oak 18 in $S 84\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E 188\frac{1}{2}$ W oak 14 in $S 86^{\circ} W 167\frac{1}{2}$

The Bearing trees only one was standing (and the stump of
the other one) which was a Black oak 8 in rather a
small one $S 64^{\circ} E 78$ = thence $S 87^{\circ} W 40.45$ chains to place
