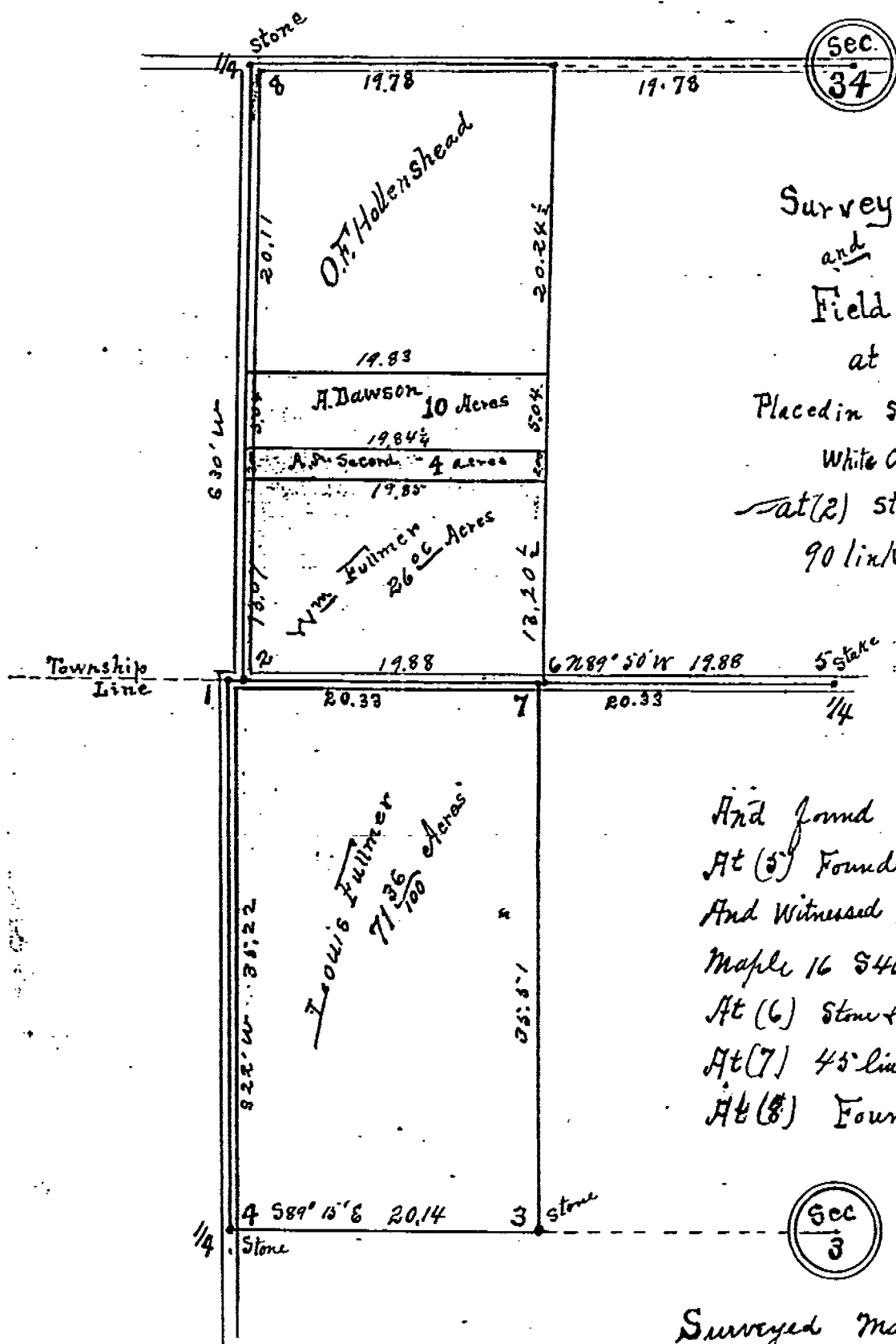

 Placed in stone stake & tile under them

White Oak 15 S 87 $\frac{3}{4}$ W 190 $\frac{1}{2}$ Run Oak 16 N 53 $\frac{1}{4}$ E 91

at (2) Stone with Large Stake & Tile under it
 90 links East of Corner at (1)

At (3) - Sugar 12 N 43 $\frac{3}{4}$ W 18 links

Same tree as in Agerters Survey

At (4) Old government W. Oak

Stump remaining Examined Same

And found marks plainly Set large Boulder

At (5) Found old $\frac{1}{4}$ stake placed in new stake

And Witnessed Hickory 10 N 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 34 Elm 30 N 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 49 $\frac{1}{2}$

Maple 16 S 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 69

At (6) Stone & stake Maple 16 N 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 88 $\frac{1}{4}$

At (7) 45 links west of (6) maple 16 N 9 $\frac{1}{4}$ E 89 $\frac{1}{2}$ Same

At (8) Found old stake - Set Stone with Brick

under it. All other corners

Are marked with stakes or

stones.
