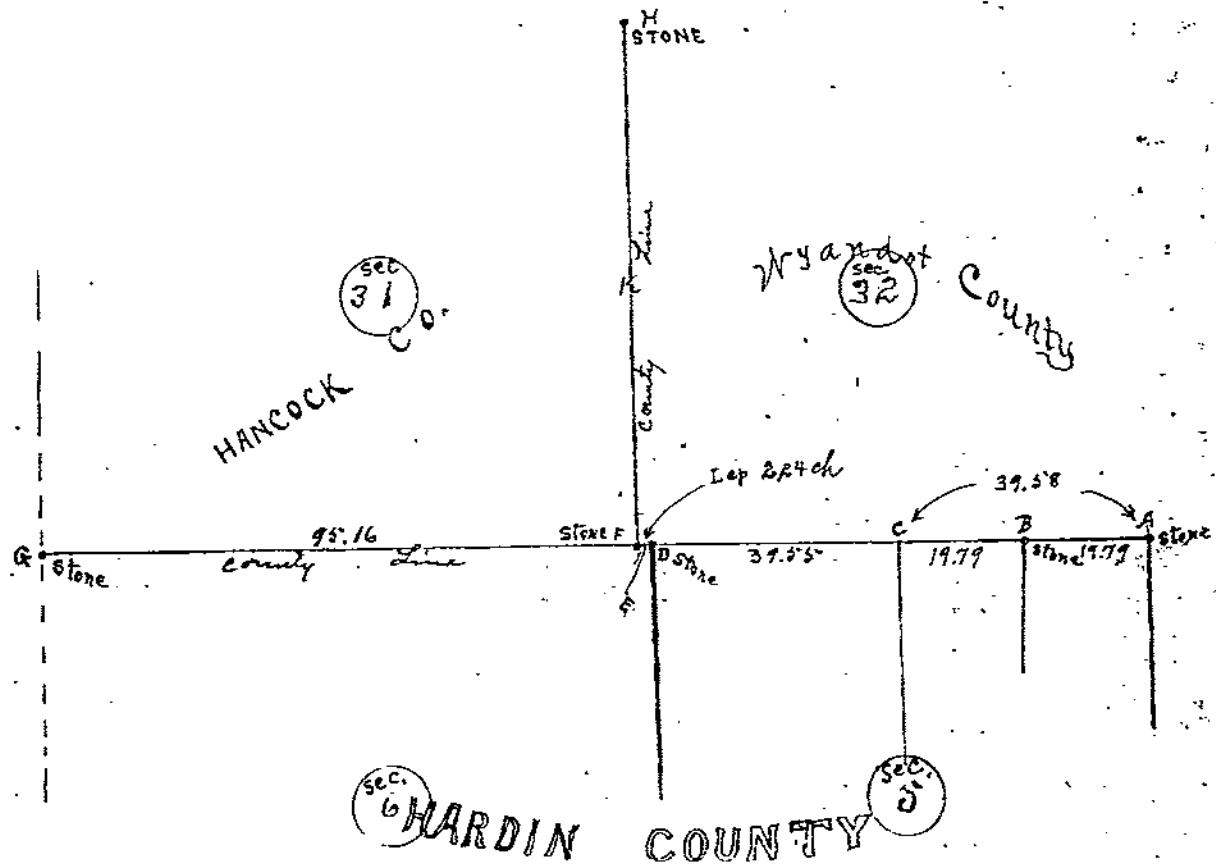

Began April 24th 1895 and Concluded
October 23rd 1895

Sec 31 & 32 T2S R 12E & Sec 5 & 6 T2S R 12E East.



- Notes: at H: Found stone set to sections 29, 30, 31 & 32 T2S R 12E
Thence South 15° W on Random
- 40.57 Pendletons Survey 1866 made search for 1/4 post at K found no
trace though tallying closely with old fence line running East and
West
- 81.18 Set Temporary Sec. Corner to sec 31
- A = Found stone set at N.E. corner of sec 5 T2S R 12E
Thence North 89° 45' W
- B = 19.79 Chains from A Found 1/4 1/4 post in N.E. Quarter of sec 5
- C = 39.58 Chains from A Made search for 1/4 to sec 6 but found none
Set Temporary post
- D = 79.13 Chains from A or 39.58 Chains from C Found old Stake
For corner to sections 5 & 6 on county line. Remains of old Ash Witness
Still Standing: Tally Satisfactory for position and is good state of Preservation
Found old score marks
