2. Big boulder on stake.
North 1/4 post of Sec 11 Twp 4 S R 14 East.
3. Stons Sec corner of Sections 2, 3, 10 & 11
4. Stone on Walnut stake
West 1/4 post of Sec 11 Twp 4 S R 14 E.
5. Lime stone on stake
6. Center of Section Eleven (11) Twp 4 S R 14 E.
Large stone on stake.
Cottonwood 36 S 35 1/2° E 18 links
7. East 1/4 post of Section 11 Twp 4 S R 14 E.
Stone on stake and broken tile
8. Stone on county line at South East corner of Sec 11
9. Stone. Rock Oak 34 S 70° E 17 links
10. Stake at South 1/4 post of Sec 11. One county line.
11. Stone on stake
- 12, 13 & 14 Stone on stake and broken tile
15. Stone on stake and broken bricks
16. Stone on stake and coal
